PEDCO was commissioned by the United States Postal Service to design a 30,000 square foot branch post office for a suburban community. The new facility was required to have a 24-hour self-service lobby, canopies on two sides, and a large, 18-foot clear height work room, in addition to the usual customer service areas. The result was an aesthetically pleasing building that exceeds its functional requirements.
