scope

Procter & Gamble planned to build a new 10,000 square foot fitness center for the company's corporate headquarters. After researching the "mecca" of fitness centers in Dallas, Texas, PEDCO designed the fitness center to include a lobby, testing area, offices, aerobic equipment, nautilus stations, free weights, aerobic exercise room, and locker and shower facilities.

Indirect cove lighting was employed in the aerobics area to eliminate glare for the exercisers. Wall mirrors were used for technique observation and to create greater width because the space was unusually long and narrow. Because of the success of this project, the design and implementation became the model for other fitness centers throughout the company.
