scope

This rapidly growing parish in suburban Cincinnati had outgrown its rectory offices, which were located in a basement space. To meet the needs of the growing parish, a 4,000 square foot expansion was planned. Careful consideration was given to assuring that the architectural features of the addition complemented that of the existing church, striving to create a building that appeared and functioned as if it were part of the original construction of the Church. The needs of functionality, security, and acoustic privacy were all achieved, in addition to the selection of interior design elements make for an attractive workplace, while remaining on budget.

A separate heat recovery HVAC system serves the office addition via 10 VAV zones, providing economical comfort conditioning. The project also resolves two other persistent problems: a site drainage issue, and more importantly, consolidation of separate fire alarm systems into a single system with user-friendly alarm reset capability.
